A quarter of a mile long; five storeys high; 1,200 beds; 1,700 construction workers. 60,000 cu m of concrete; 6,100 tonnes of rebar. When construction work began in Skanska's £334 million University Hospital Walsgrave project, was the largest Private Finance Initiative healthcare scheme in the country.

Renov8 were awarded a £530,000 supply and fit contract to fit out the Facilities Management building which is the operations hub of the complex. Working within the PFI umbrella the project was conducted under tight timescales and involved project management of multiple trades including FM, Insulation, Security Access, Flooring, Decoration, as well as Doors/Doorsets, Ironmongery, Skirting, Architraves and Windowboards
